XXXV International Symposium on Multiparticle Dynamics

Place and date

The 35th meeting of the International Symposium on Multiparticle Dynamics (ISMD) will be held at Kroměříž, Czech Republic, The town of Kroměříž, famous for its Arcibishopal chateau and two gardens comprising a unique whole, is placed on the UNESCO list of monuments. It is located in South-East Moravia, about 170 km from Vienna and Bratislava, 260 km from Prague and Cracow and about 360 km from Budapest. The dates of the meeting are August 9 (arrival day) to August 15 (departure after lunch). The scientific sessions are scheduled to begin the morning of August 10.

Conference fee

Accommodation

The participants will be housed directly inside the conference building in the premises of Secondary Vocation and Apprentice Training Centre (http://www.sosukm.cz/), Pavlákova 3942, Kroměříž. Each room is offered as a single with social facilities. Those coming with an accompanying person will be assigned a double room. Those who wish to live in a hotel can contact directly penzion Holub (http://www.holub.penzion.com/) or other hotels in Kroměříž (http://www.kromeriz.biz/accommodation_kromeriz.html). In this case corresponding reduction of the conference fee will be made.

Social program

A welcome reception will be held on Tuesday evening, August 9 in the Flower Garden. On Thursday, August 11 there will be a guided tour to Kroměříž chateau followed by wine tasting in Archbishop's wine cellars. Half a day excursion is planned for the afternoon of Saturday, August 13. The excursion will encompass the historic town of Olomouc. A conference dinner is scheduled for Sunday evening, August 14.

Travel

The nearest large international airports are Vienna (VIA), Prague (PRG) and Bratislava (BTS).

In the early afternoon August 9 transportation from Prague will be arranged to bring participants to Kroměříž. On sufficient demands of the participants of Quark Matter 2005 conference (http://qm2005.kfki.hu/) transportation from Budapest to Kroměříž could be arranged. On Monady afternoon, August 15 we also plan to organize a transportation of the ISMD 2005 participants from Kroměřiž to Prague. Details will be posted once the travel schedules of participants are known.

For those unable to use the conference bus, regularly scheduled commercial service is offered either from Prague, Viena, Bratislava, Budapest or Cracow. Train from Vienna or Bratislava to Kroměříž takes approximately 2-3 hours, from Prague 4-5 hours and from Budapest or Cracow 5-6 hours.
