The proceedings will be published in 6x9 inch format printed version of AIP Proceedings. While AIP generally needs a hard copy of the final manuscript, electronic submission of the final papers is strongly encouraged, particularly since this results in a much higher quality for the final proceedings volume. We can accept electronic files in either PDF or PS formats, and often MS Word files as well.

Each paper must be submitted together with a signed Transfer of Copyright form <a href="http://proceedings.aip.org/proceedings/tca\_blank.pdf">http://proceedings.aip.org/proceedings/tca\_blank.pdf</a> as well as all necessary permissions <a href="http://proceedings.aip.org/proceedings/permission.pdf">http://proceedings.aip.org/proceedings/permission.pdf</a> for material taken from other sources.

Papers in electronic format (talks – max. 10 pages, posters – max. 5 pages) have to be send to <u>pic2005@ipnp.troja.mff.cuni.cz</u> not later than 9 September 2005
